January 23 – February 21, 2026

Process + Perception

Curated by Andy Thompson

Showcasing process-driven artists whose layered two and three-dimensional works, ranging from collage, assemblage, painting, and weaving, to invite close looking.

Featured Artist: Rachel Brunhild

Brunhild's weavings are a practice of connecting the body and the breath, creating artwork that becomes a form of meditation.

March 6 – 28, 2026

THRESHOLDS

Organized by the National Council on Education of the Ceramics Arts

Thresholds is a design-focused ceramic exhibition that positions ceramic furniture as a critical mediator in the dialogue between the volume of the human body and architectural space.

Featured Artist: Alexandra Collins

Collins combines the historic act of painting with innovative tools such as computers and digital lenses to abstract and reimagine our world.

Since 1966, DAM's annual scholarship program has partnered with CCS, Cranbrook, and Wayne State to showcase student artists each year, awarding 3 scholarships for artistic excellence.

Featured Artist: Megan Major

Major explores the tension between nature's resilience and human impact, using digital media and the unpredictable cyanotype process to reflect its beauty and fragility.

Friends: Furry & Fictional

This open call exhibition explores the bond between humans and animals, featuring work inspired by real or imagined creatures.
